outdoor activities year-round, from fishing and boating on the 43-mile-long Lake Pend Oreille to skiing in the nearby Selkirk Mountains. Seasons at Sandpoint is a nine-acre development that fronts 1,800 feet of private lakeshore on a peninsula adjacent to downtown. Opened in 2007, the community has completed 72 condominiums so far. There are eight three-story, three-bedroom town houses, each

more than 4,000 square feet, in the latest phase. They include balconies, covered porches, gas fireplaces and two-car garages; rental opportunities are available. The clubhouse has a lounge, a fitness center, a lakefront pool and whirlpools. Yoga classes are held regularly in a building nearby. There is also an area for private parties in the clubhouse, and concierges will make arrangements for meals on the beach or on a deck overlooking the lake. Shuttle service is offered to the Schweitzer Mountain Resort ski area, about 11 miles north, and there are numerous nearby golf courses. The closest major airport is an hour-and-a half-drive southwest in Spokane, Wash.

With three residential enclaves, a 250-slip marina, a 120-room hotel, a beach club and the village of shops, restaurants and galleries completed, the development is now working on two new residential clusters, a <u>spa</u> and an 18-hole <u>Gary Player</u>-designed golf course. One residential area, Las Colinas, will have 71 residences mostly in adjoining pairs on hillsides between holes of the golf course. The other, VistaMar, will be on bluffs near the beach and will initially consist of 16 casita-style residences in four buildings, with a 47-unit condominium complex nearby. A rental program is offered to owners. The La Paz airport has direct flights from Los Angeles.
